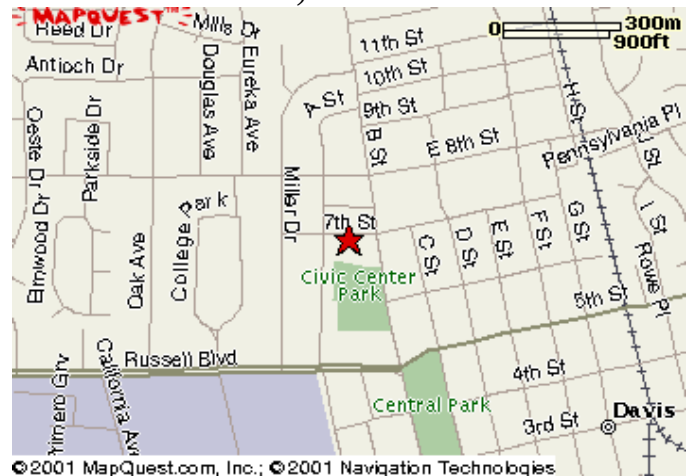


Prez Says from Bill Rains
