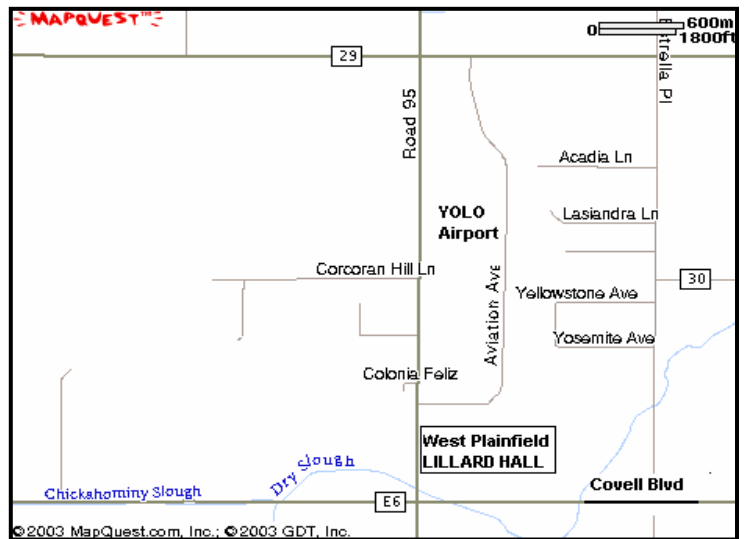
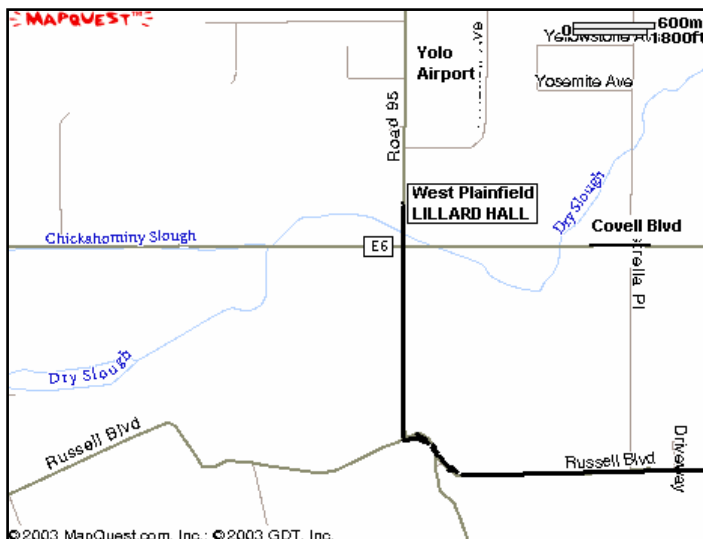
**ANNUAL DINNER, SATURDAY FEBRUARY 21, 2004
